WELCOME

Dear colleagues, guests and airway friends,

It is our great honour and pleasure to address you on behalf of the Croatian Society of Difficult Airway Management of the Croatian Medical Association (CMA-CSDAM) and to welcome you to the 5th Croatian Congress of Airway Management with International Participation, which will be held on 28th February and 1st March 2025, at the Dubrovnik Hotel, in Zagreb, Croatia.

ABSTRACTS AND ARTICLES

Participants, who intend to present an oral presentation or an e-poster, must submit an abstract to be reviewed by the Scientific Committee. After accepting the abstract, the Scientific Committee will decide on the format of the presentation (oral presentation or e-poster). Accepted abstracts will be published in the Book of Abstracts.

The abstract submission deadline HAS BEEN EXTENDED TO 9TH FEBRUARY 2025.

Instructions for writing the abstract:

- The abstract language: Croatian or English
- The abstract's title size: up to 25 words
- The abstract size (without title, author's name, institution and keywords): up to 400 words
- The abstract font: Arial 10 pts
- The abstract must contain: the full title of the work (concise and informative), the full names and surnames of the author and all co-authors without titles, the names of the author's and all co-authors' institutions with the author's and co-author's city and country, the corresponding author's e-mail; content; keywords

e-mail:

- The abstract content: structured abstract depending on the type of work
 - Research study: introduction and goal of the research, materials and methods (or subjects and methods or patients and methods), results, conclusion; references (optional up to 3 maximum)
 - Case report: introduction, case report, discussion, conclusion, references (up to 3 optional)



- Review paper: introduction and objective, discussion, conclusion, references (optional up to 3 maximum).
- Keywords: 3-6 words according to Index Medicus: Medical Subject Headings (MESH).
- References: not mandatory, optional up to 3 maximum; they are marked with ordinal numbers according to the order in which they appear in the text of the abstract; reference style according to NLM standards http://www.nlm.nih.gov/bsd/uniform_requirements.html
- Abstracts should be submitted without figures, graphs and tables.

Instructions for sending the abstract:

- The abstract should be sent to e-mail: tanjagoranovic@hotmail.com
- The corresponding author is responsible for ensuring that all co-authors are familiar with the
 content of the abstract before sending it and with any further communication related to the
 abstract.
- The maximum number of authors per abstract is 6 (first author plus 5 co-authors).
- When registering, mark the author who will be the presenter of the summary of the work.
- The Scientific Committee will decide on the format of presentation of the abstract after accepting it: oral presentation or e-poster.
- <u>Presentation</u> of abstracts, orally or e-poster, <u>will not be possible without registration and</u> payment of registration fee.
- Accepted abstracts for which registration and payment of the registration fee are made will be published in the Book of Abstracts.
- <u>If the presenter of the abstract fails to register and pay the registration fee in a timely manner,</u> the abstract will be withdrawn.

Instructions for writing and sending the article:

- Selected and reviewed *in extenso* articles (review or research paper) will be published in a regular issue of the indexed journal *Periodicum Biologorum*.
- In extenso articles are written in English according to the instructions of the journal *Periodicum Biologorum*
